trying journey

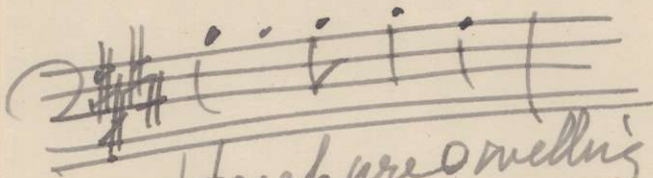
With all love & sincerity
